Eligibility: Spring 2018 graduating high school seniors who plan to attend an accredited college or university following graduation, and who either:

- a. Attend high school in Boone County or Jefferson City Missouri
- OR**
- b. Attend high school elsewhere but have a parent employed in the insurance industry in Boone County or Jefferson City Missouri

Guidelines: Candidates will write an essay on the following topic:

Some experts believe technology being developed to reduce the number and severity of automobile accidents will eventually cause auto insurance cost to go down. However, other experts argue these technologies are expensive and not dependable, and therefore could actually cause insurance costs to increase. Do you think insurance costs will go up or down and do you think including these technologies is a good thing or not? Be sure to include evidence to support your argument.

Essay format:

- Double-spaced with size 12 font
- 2-3 pages in length with one inch margins
- Citation of references required

Please include a cover sheet (in addition to the essay pages) stating your name, email address, telephone number, mailing address, the high school you attend, the accredited college or university you plan to attend, your degree/focus of study, and how you meet the eligibility requirements. Staple the cover sheet securely to the essay. **DO NOT** show your name on the essay itself. Essays will be judged anonymously.
